NOTICE OF SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Youngs River Lewis and Clark Water District (District) intends to enter a sole source contract in accordance with OAR 137-047-0275 with AriaFiltra in order to acquire controls changes on the District's AriaFiltra MF System pursuant to the YR L&C Board Resolution 24-4 attached.

The District is performing two projects. The first will add controls to perform system LRV ambient calculations, which are mandated by the Oregon Health Authority. The second is for changes made to daily integrity tests of AriaFiltra membranes utilized by the existing Pall Water Filtration System. The District's Pall Water filtration controls system is specifically designed AriaFiltra. The use of AriaFiltra to modify the controls, versus the services of other controls providers, is necessary to continue to optimize treatment plant operation, regulatory compliance, and controls system operational capacity.

The cost of the AriaFiltra controls services is approximately \$17,154.

Any person may submit a written protest specific to this sole-source notice within seven days of the date of this public notice. The protest shall provide a detailed statement of the legal and factual grounds for the protest, a description of the resulting harm to the Affected Person, and the relief requested. Protests shall be handled pursuant to OAR 137-047-0710.

Written protests must be delivered to the District no later than Friday September 20th by 3:30pm. Written protests received after the closing date and time are late and will not be considered. Postmarks, facsimiles, and electronic protests will NOT be considered. Protests must be submitted in writing to the Youngs River Lewis and Clark Water District, Attn: Carl Gifford, Superintendent, 34583 US-101 Business, Astoria, OR 97103.
